

CAMPERS AT A SALVATION ARMY CAMP

1. Suggested items to bring to camp:

- BIBLE
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Comb/brush
- Personal toiletry items
- Soap
- Tissues
- Towels/washcloth
- Sunscreen
- At least 1 swimsuit(must be one-piece)
- Clothing changes for at least the number of camping days
- Uniform(Gurard, Sunbeam, SAAC, Salvation Army)
- At least 1 dressy outfit for special banquets, dressy meetings, Sunday if they are not Jr. or Sr. soldiers.
- Play shoes/dress shoes
- Socks
- Warm jacket, sweater
- Pajamas
- Paper/pen/pencil
- Pillow
- Sleeping bag OR
- Twin sheets and blanket

Helpful but not absolutely necessary: raincoat, umbrella, flashlight, bug repellent

NOTE: Since all camps will have campers in cabins by age groupings, it is necessary for campers from the same family to pack in separate bags.

NOTE: Do not send brand new clothes with campers. Important—mark clothing, towels and personal belongings with first and last names. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

2. All medications must be in their original bottles with that child's name on the label. Any medication should be placed in a plastic bag with child's name clearly marked to be given to Driver/Leader before leaving town. It will be turned in to the nurse upon arrival.

3. DO NOT BRING: Money(Canteen will be provided daily and is already paid for)

Weapons

Electronic Games(like GameBoys, etc.)

These items will be taken away from any camper who brings them.
