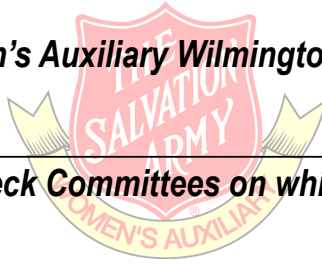
Purpose

In addition to raising funds, the Women's Auxiliary helps provide volunteers for The Salvation Army's projects during the Christmas season and throughout the year as the need arises.

Standing Committees

_____ **Finance:** This committee prepares a budget and plans fund raisers. Sponsors the Emma Lossen Campership Fund and the Helen McCarl Cadet Fund.

_____ **Sponsor:** This committee finds sponsors to support fund raisers. Ask businesses to include the Auxiliary in their yearly budget and apply for grants.

_____ **Membership:** This committee helps plan ways to find new members and encourage Auxiliary members to seek out prospective members. Assigns members to give out membership pins and handbooks and oversees making of name tags. Assists with visitor information.

_____ **Handbook:** This committee compiles and distributes the Auxiliary handbook to our members.

_____ **Public Relations:** This committee is in charge of getting all activities and projects of the Auxiliary advertised through the newspaper, radio, TV, flyers, etc.

Christmas Committees

_____ **Applications:** This committee is under the leadership of The Salvation Army. Volunteers fill out applications for those applying for help at Christmas.

_____ **Angel Tree:** This committee is in charge of securing volunteers to man the Angel Tree in the mall during Christmas. You may sign up for this committee if you are interested in volunteering to help those in the mall who choose to take an Angel off of the tree. They also arrange for small Angel Trees to be set up in stores and offices.

_____ **Toy Shop:** A Salvation Army project. Volunteers help The Salvation Army set up the Toy Shop. They help to sort and arrange the toys, stuff stockings and wrap gifts for the nursing homes. They prepare bags for those who were not taken off the Angel Tree and check all bags to make sure toys, clothing, etc. are appropriate.

_____ **Stockings:** This committee encourages churches, individuals, schools and organizations to fill stockings. The Salvation Army provides a list of appropriate items for filling the stockings.

Year Round Committees

_____ **Decorating:** This committee sets up and decorates the tables for the General meetings and special events.

_____ **Hostess:** This committee greets, makes everyone feel welcome, and helps to bring in covered dishes at General meetings and special events.

_____ **Door Prize:** This committee furnishes Door Prizes for the monthly General Meetings

_____ **Layette:** This committee prepares layettes to give to mothers who need this service. May is layette month and all auxiliary members are asked to bring layette items to the May General meeting. Layettes are prepared and kept at The Salvation Army church for distribution to specific organizations and individuals as the need arises.

_____ **Prayer:** This committee undergirds The Salvation Army and the Auxiliary leadership, ministry and personal needs of the Auxiliary with prayer. They take prayer requests and report answered prayers.

_____ **Telephone:** This committee keeps the Auxiliary informed of all meetings and special events. The chairman is responsible for notifying her committee to call for meal reservations and specific instructions for the monthly meetings.
