Standing Committees:

___ **Fundraising:** This committee prepares a budget and plans fundraisers, sponsors the Emma Lossen Campership Fund and the Helen McCarl Cadet Fund.

___ **Sponsor:** This committee finds sponsors to support fundraisers; asks businesses to include the Auxiliary in their yearly budget and applies for grants.

___ **Membership:** This committee helps plan ways to find new members and encourages Auxiliary members to seek out prospective members. Assigns members to give out membership pins and handbooks and oversees making of name tags. Assists with visitor information.

___ **Handbook:** This committee compiles and distributes the Auxiliary handbook to our members.

___ **Public Relations:** This committee is in charge of getting all activities and projects of the Auxiliary advertised through the newspaper, radio, TV, flyers, etc.

Christmas Committees:

___ **Applications:** This committee is under the leadership of The Salvation Army. Volunteers fill out applications for those applying for help with Christmas.

___ **Angel Tree:** This committee is in charge of securing volunteers to man the Angel Tree in the mall during Christmas. Volunteers assist people to choose an Angel off the tree. They also arrange for small Angel Trees to be set up in stores and offices.

___ **Toy Shop:** This is a project of The Salvation Army. Volunteers help set up the Toy Shop by sorting and arranging toys, preparing stockings and processing gifts/clothing for Angels, as well as assisting with distribution processes.

___ **Stockings:** This committee encourages churches, individuals, schools and organizations to fill stockings. The Salvation Army provides stockings and a list of acceptable items for filling them.

Year Round Committees:

___ **Decorating:** This committee sets up and decorates the tables for the General meetings and special events.

___ **Hostess:** This committee greets, makes everyone feel welcome and helps to bring in covered dishes at the General meetings and special events.

___ **Door Prize:** This committee furnishes door prizes for the monthly General Meetings.

___ **Layette:** This committee prepares layettes to give to mothers who need the service. May is layette month and all Auxiliary members are asked to bring layette items to the General Meeting. Layettes are distributed to organizations and individuals as the need arises.

___ **Prayer:** This committee undergirds The Salvation Army and the Auxiliary leadership, ministry, and personal needs of the Auxiliary with prayer. They take prayer requests and report answered prayers.

___ **Telephone:** This committee keeps the Auxiliary informed of all meetings and special events. The chairman is responsible for notifying her committee to call for meal reservations and any specific instructions for monthly meetings.
